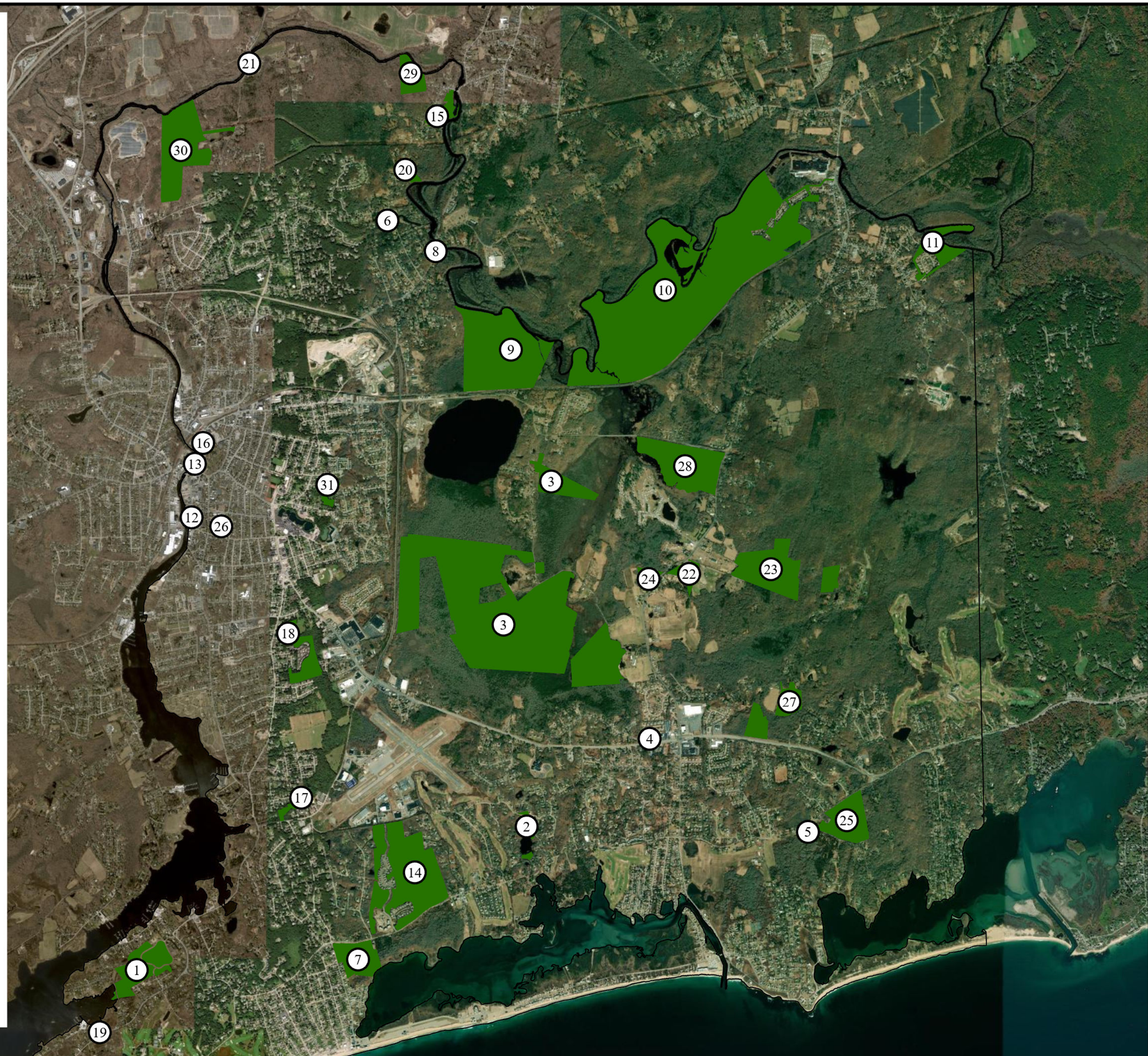

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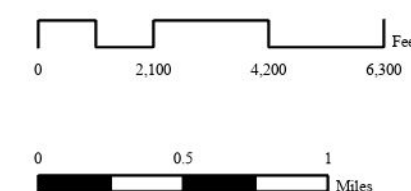
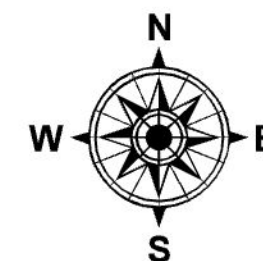

***1. Avondale Farm Preserve**

Coastal grassland, tidal marsh and scrubland. Birdwatching and native wildflowers. A paved 0.6 mi loop and well-groomed grass trails.

Location: Parking at Grassland Way and at the end of Quail Run

***2. Dr. Lewis Pond Preserve**

Glacially carved terrain dropping to White Cedar swamp and kettle pond.

Location: Links Passage

***3. Crandall Family Preserve**

Expansive Atlantic white cedar swamp, peat bogs and ponds. Short, accessible trail to swamp overlook.

Location: End of Pound Road off Rt 91.

4. Quaker (Friends) Burial Ground

On a knoll at the site of the first Quaker/Friends Meetinghouse in Westerly.

Location: 220 Post Road

***5. Haversham Preserve**

Forested wetland with a short trail featuring a long boardwalk. Trail connects to Weekapaug Foundation's Noyes Neck Farm.

Location: At the corner of Shore Rd and Haversham. Parking at Noyes Neck Overlook.

***6. Wildwood**

Forested wetland with a stream and short trail.

Location: 38 Forrestal Dr.

***7. Winnapaug Farm Preserve**

Agricultural land with wooded trails leading to Winnapaug Pond.

Location: 109 Shore Rd.

8. Thomas Hill Tract

Land providing natural flood mitigation along Pawcatuck River.

Location: East of Rt. 3 and the Meeting House Bridge.

***9. Riverwood Preserve**

Woodland, rocky ridges and wetlands with abundant wildlife. Includes Boy Scout Camp Quequatuck.

Location: Off Boy Scout Drive with parking along Old Hopkinton Rd.

***10. Grills Preserve**

Expansive upland forest and freshwater wetlands along the Pawcatuck River in Bradford. Large hill with exposed bedrock and scenic views.

Location: 198 Bowling Lane. Trails connect to Hopkinton's Grills Wildlife Sanctuary.

11. Pine Hollow

Woodlands and wetlands providing habitat along Pawcatuck River

Location: Laudone Dr.

12. Community Garden

Location: 145 Main St.

13. Industrial Trust

Historic building, former Industrial Trust bank. Tenant-occupied

Location: 10 High St.

***14. Dr. John Champlin Glacier Park**

Trails across the Charlestown moraine with kettle ponds, ridges, ocean overlook and educational signs

Location: Parking at 1 Kettle Cl. or the intersection of Tom Harvey Rd. and Newbury Dr.

***15. Flora Whiteley Preserve**

Wetlands, forest and meadows with paddle access to Pawcatuck River

Location: Next to 193 Potter Hill Rd.

16. Ocean Community UNITED Theatre

Part of WLT's Urban Initiative and lively venue for music, movies and more

Location: 5 Canal St.

***17. Mastuxet Brook Greenway South**

Rocky, wooded terrain along Mastuxet Brook.

Location: Behind Rotary Park (91 Airport Rd.).

18. Mastuxet Brook Greenway North

Red maple swamp near the headwaters of Mastuxet Brook.

Location: Between East Ave. and Franklin St.

19. Colonel Willie Cove Preserve

Tidal wetlands along the lower Pawcatuck estuary.

Location: 175 Watch Hill Rd.

20. Anderson Preserve

Upland forest with a vernal pool and a sandy canoe landing accessible from the Pawcatuck River.

Location: 119 Potter Hill Rd.

21. Beriah Lewis Farm

Conserved pasture along the Pawcatuck River used for grazing livestock.

Location: 108 Boombridge Rd.

22. Moorhouse Farm Preserve

Agricultural field and forest adjacent to the Trombino Ballfields

Location: 109 Dunn's Corner Rd.

***23. Wahaneeta Preserve**

A former Girl Scout camp with woodlands, streams, a pond, cabin, pavilion and historic relics.

Location: 118 Moorhouse Rd.

24. Haggerty Family Preserve

Forested wetland and agricultural field.

Location: 100 Dunn's Corner Rd.

25. Hence Conservation Easement

WLT-held Conservation Easement at Hillandale Farm.

Location: 6 Haversham Rd

26. Hawke Wood

A block of forested wetland in downtown.

Location: 26 Cross St.

***27. Sunnycroft Preserve**

Part of a historic homestead with forested wetlands and agricultural fields.

Location: 133 S Woody Hill Rd.

***28. Barlow Nature Preserve**

WLT's headquarters with trails, a farm stand and more. Come visit us here!

Location: 449 Westerly Bradford Rd.

***29. Cottrell Family Preserve**

Upland and wetland forests along the Pawcatuck River in Potter Hill.

Location: 29 Christian Hill Rd. Parking south of 170 Potter Hill Rd.

***30. Champlin Farm Preserve**

Farm fields, forested valleys and rocky uplands along the Pawcatuck River near White Rock.

Location: 64 Boombridge Rd.

31. Bonnie Brook Preserve

A small, forested wetland surrounding a cul-de-sac off Tower St.

Location: Gardener Dr.

***** = Trails/public access



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
